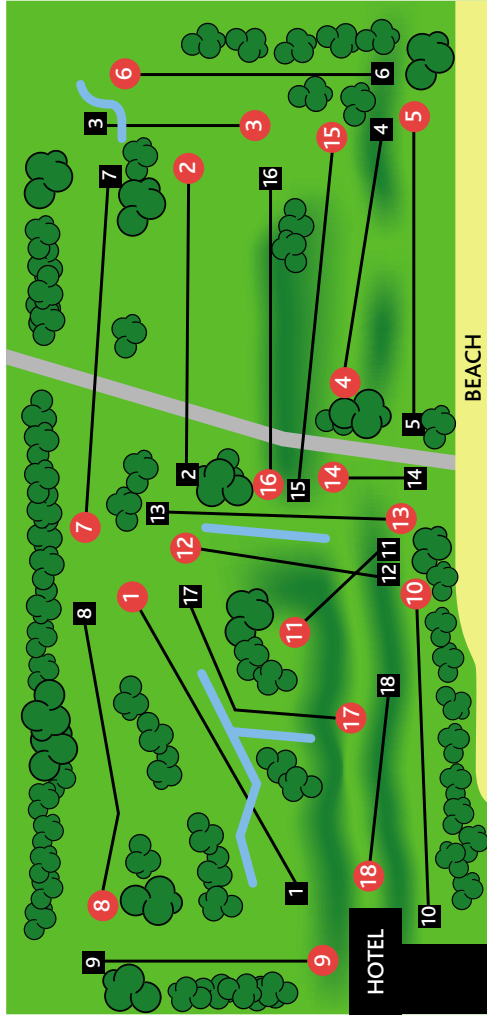

LOCAL RULES

PATHS

1. The Public Footpath and banks across the 2nd, 7th, 15th and 16th Fairways are an integral part of the course.
Ball must be played as it lies, or declared unplayable, (rule 28)
2. Fencing at the base of the 7th fairway banking. If a ball strikes this fencing, the ball must be replayed without penalty.
3. A ball coming into close proximity to the post and ropes between the 1st tee and 18th, relief may be taken under Rule 24-2b (1). (Immovable Obstructions).
4. A ball on any gravel or shell path may be dropped at the nearest point of relief no nearer the hole. Relief must be taken under Rule 25-1b.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

1. In any area of Ground Under Repair play is prohibited. The player shall not play from or take his stance in any such area. Relief must be taken under Rule 25-1b.

OUT OF BOUNDS

1. A ball played through or over any boundary fence or hedge or over any line of white markers posts is out of bounds.
2. The area surrounding the Hotel i.e. Rockery, Sunken Garden, path to the left of the 10th tee and the practice putting area are out of bounds.
3. 14th hole. A ball played onto or over the path to the right of the hole is out of bounds.

PROTECTIVE NETTING TO THE LEFT OF THE 3RD GREEN

1. Netting on 3rd. If a ball lands in close proximity to the netting which interferes with his stance or intended swing a player must drop his ball in the nearest dropping zone without penalty under Rule 24-2b. (Immovable Obstructions).
2. The area behind the netting facing the 6th tee defined by green marker posts is G.U.R. from which play is prohibited. If a player's ball lies in this area or if it interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 25-1.

STAKED TREES

1. If such a tree interferes with a player's normal stance or area of intended swing, the ball must be lifted and dropped without penalty in accordance with Rule 24-2b(1). (Immovable Obstructions).

STONES IN BUNKERS

1. Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.
